 Services will be bringing an additional resolution to the County Commission to do
 additional interior work to bring this facility into full compliance with ADA.
- Outreach We are scheduling many events in September. One that you should put on your calendars is National Voter Registration Day, September 17. We will be partnering with the Memphis Grizzlies and the MSCS Schools to do a student event at Fed Ex Forum, likely from 10am until noon.
- Overdue Campaign Finance Filings Lists of overdue filings for both current candidates and those who are only required to file semi-annually since they do not have an election this year are in your folder.
- PLEJ Conference I attended the Partnership for Large Election Jurisdiction conference in Minneapolis in July. The conference was excellent; one of the best I've ever been to. Membership in PLEJ is limited to jurisdictions that have a minimum of 300,000 voters, so everyone there are facing the same problems. We did a tabletop exercise that was very helpful. I saw a demo of a help desk ticket tracking system that we plan to implement for fall. Getting back from the conference was difficult as it was in the middle of the Delta / Crowdstrike air travel meltdown. I eventually managed to get home on Amtrak.
