**Primary Election Ballot**

Your primary election ballot will contain six or seven races depending upon where you live. All ballots will have the race for Governor. All ballots will have the correct district for the US House of Representatives, the Tennessee House of Representatives, the State Executive Committeeman and the State Executive Committeewoman. Voters who live in Tennessee Senate District 29, 31, and 33 will have the correct race for their district on their ballots. Voters who live in Tennessee Senate District 30 and 32 will not see a Tennessee Senate race on their ballots since those districts will not be on the ballot until 2024.

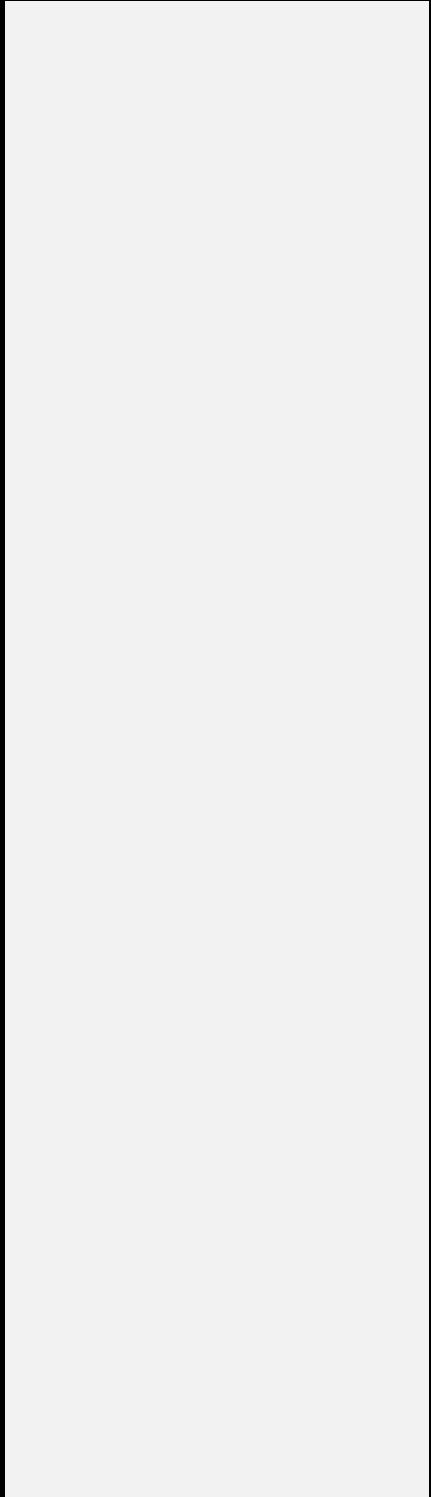
