ACCEPTABLE PHOTO ID

- Any of the following IDs may be used, even if expired:
- Tennessee driver license with your photo
 - United States Passport
 - Photo ID issued by the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security
 - Photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government
 - United States Military photo ID
 - TN handgun carry permit with your photo
