BUDGET FOR 2022:

During the July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 budget period there is one scheduled election, May county primary. There is not a lot of optional expenses for elections. AOE will ask to increase the officer pay on election day to \$300. This had great results during November as we attracted a better caliber of worker which made our election successful.

OLD BUSINESS: none

NEW BUSINESS:

AOE Phillips stated we will start working on redistricting once the census date is released in June 2021. The County Commission will draw their districts, then we will modify any precinct lines by the January 1, 2022 deadline. Then the State will submit their redistricting plan in January 2022. Everything has to be completed before filings for the May election begin.

DAOE Joe Young thanked all law enforcement for their support during our elections. Local, County and Federal were all very cooperative. He will draft a thank you letter to each.

Sissy Ellison, Republican Voting Machine Tech, is retiring December 31, 2020.

ATTORNEY REPORT:

Attorney Varela stated that the Latroy Williams case was dismissed.



