EARLY VOTING VS. ELECTION DAY VOTING



CAN vote between September 15 & 30

CAN vote at any available polling location

SHOULD view all early voting times and locations at shelbyvote.org.

All Voters

MUST take a state or governmentissued photo ID to vote

SHOULD study the sample ballot at shelbyvote.com before they go to the polls.



Election Day Voters

MUST vote on October 5

MUST vote at their assigned polling location

SHOULD find their assigned polling location at shelbyvote.org.
















10-STEP VOTER CHECKLIST



Choose Early Voting or Election Day voting,



If you plan to vote on Election Day, find your assigned polling location at shelbyvote.com.



Review the sample ballot before you go. There are 17 Memphis mayoral candidates and up to 10 candidates in a couple of the Memphis City Council races.



Using the map at shelbyvote.com, determine which Memphis City Council district race you're voting on.



Check shelbyvote.com before you go to ensure there are no polling place changes due to unforeseen circumstances.



Grab your state or government-issued photo ID before heading out to the polls.



Use the machine-marked ballot or request a handmarked ballot.



Take your time and double-check your selections before casting your ballot.
