MEMPHIS CHARTER AMENDMENT REFERENDUM

**Ordinance No. 5464
ONE CENT GASOLINE TAX**

Shall the Home Rule Charter of the City of Memphis, Tennessee, be amended by adding the following provisions to read as follows:

“The Council of the City of Memphis is authorized by Ordinance to authorize the City of Memphis to levy and collect a one cent gasoline tax on all sales within the city and to authorize the use of revenue derived there from for budget expenditures for public transportation.”

I, Brian Collins, Director of Finance for the City of Memphis do hereby certify that the net revenue increase to the City if this Amendment is adopted is estimated to be \$3,000,000 annually.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012**

Federal or state government issued photo ID is now required to vote in person, unless an exception applies. College student IDs will not be accepted. City or County employees IDs will not be accepted. To learn more about the new law and its exceptions, please call (901) 222-1200 or visit GoVoteTN.com.

Any of the following IDs may be used, even if expired:

- Tennessee drivers license with your photo
- United States Passport
- Photo ID issued by the Tennessee Dept. of Safety and Homeland Security
- Photo ID issued by the federal or any state government
- United States Military photo ID
- State-issued handgun carry permit with your photo
