INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT

To the Members of the
Shelby County Election Commission

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Shelby County Election Commission, solely to assist you in ensuring the accuracy of the tabulation of votes and maintaining the integrity of the election process for the Federal and State General and Municipal Elections held on November 8, 2022. Management of the Shelby County Election Commission is responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the tabulation of votes and maintaining the integrity of the election process. The Shelby County Election Commission has agreed to and acknowledged that the procedures performed are appropriate to meet the intended purpose of the engagement. This report may not be suitable for any other purpose. The procedures performed may not address all the items of interest to a user of this report and may not meet the needs of all users of this report and, as such, users are responsible for determining whether the procedures performed are appropriate for their purposes.

Our procedures and findings are as follows:

Early and Pre-Election Voting Procedures

1. We examined all of the voting machines scheduled for use in early and election-day voting and verified that:
 - a) The machine ID numbers, system total numbers, and all protective seal numbers agreed with the information recorded on the Technician's Certificate.
 - b) The public ballot count was zero for each machine.
 - c) The ballot contains the proper races for the federal, state, and municipal jurisdictions as compared to the Ballot Split Report obtained from the Tennessee GIS system.
 - d) The voting location attached to the voting machine agreed to the Technician's Certificate.

Election Day Procedures

2. We were present at the Shelby County Election Commission on election day and observed the following:
 - a) The opening of the absentee ballots.
 - b) The counting of the absentee ballots by the Central Absentee Counting Board.
 - c) The tabulation of the absentee votes.
 - d) The unlocking of the early voting machines.

- e) The computer tabulation of the early voting memory sticks.
 - f) The computer tabulation of the precinct memory sticks.
3. We examined all early voting individual machine results tapes and verified that the public and protected counts agreed to the totals on the machine for each early voting machine.

Post-Election Procedures

4. In connection with the tabulation of votes recorded in the election, our procedures included the following:
- a) Agreed the machine ID numbers and protective seal numbers per the certificate of results to the Technician's Certificate for all precincts. Some minor exceptions were noted which appeared to be the result of clerical errors.
 - b) Computed the percentage of total votes received by each candidate and compared to the election results summary. No exceptions were noted.
 - c) Selected a sample of 40 two-day sequences during early voting and examined the chain of custody forms to verify that the beginning and end of day system totals were in proper sequence and accurately documented. We were unable to verify the sequence information for one two-day sequence item tested due to the end of day total information not being recorded on the form. All other items tested appeared to be properly documented.
 - d) Manually tabulated the votes for the governor's race for two election day sites selected randomly by the Administrator and agreed them to the machine tabulated results without exception.
 - e) Observed the retabulating of three election day sites and one early voting site randomly selected by the Administrator, all absentee ballots, and verified the accuracy of the original tabulation.

We were engaged by the Shelby County Election Commission to perform this agreed-upon procedures engagement and conducted our engagement in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. We were not engaged to, and did not, conduct an audit or examination engagement, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on the accuracy of the tabulation of votes and the integrity of the election process. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you. In addition, as our procedures involved the use of sampling, there is a risk that the sample selected might not have been representative of the population from which it was drawn, and the possibility exists that test results might have been different had we tested the entire population.

We are required to be independent of the Shelby County Election Commission and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements related to our agreed-upon procedures engagement.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Shelby County Election Commission and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than those specified parties.

NOTES TO TABULATION OF VOTES

1. The tabulation of votes has been corrected for clerical errors, if any, discovered in the results reported by election officials and absentee election officials.
2. Write-in votes received in early voting, election day (polling) voting, and by absentee votes are included in their respective columns. Provisional and paper ballots received on election-day at precincts are reflected in a separate column labeled "Provisional/Paper Ballot Votes," therefore, the column labeled "Regular (Polling) Votes" includes only election-day machine totals.
3. Write-in votes are maintained separately by the Shelby County Election Commission.
4. Results for official write-in candidates are presented on a separate line for their respective races in the regular (polling) votes column. All other write-in candidates are presented on a line labeled "Write-In Candidates." For the November 8, 2022 elections, there were three official write-in candidates for Governor and one for United States House of Representatives, District 9.
