The legislative branch is vested with all other powers of the county not specifically, or by necessary implication, vested in some other official of the county by the Constitution or by statute not inconsistent with this charter. In exercising its legislative functions, the legislative branch may employ, subject to budgeting limitations, special counsel, assistants, and other employees. The board of commissioners' attorney shall be appointed solely by the board of county commissioners and subject to dismissal without cause by the County Commission. However, neither the legislative branch nor the chairman of the legislative branch shall exercise executive, administrative or judicial powers or perform any functions of the mayor-county commission government delegated or assigned by the terms of this charter to other offices, branches or departments of county government. Whenever any public or private act of the state purports to authorize the county court or county commission or its chairman to perform any administrative or executive act or function, then such act or function shall be performed by the county mayor.
