WHEREAS, if demand exceeds capacity, the AOE is authorized to extend hours and/or bring in additional staff and equipment as required.

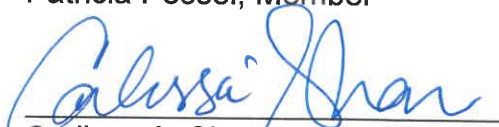

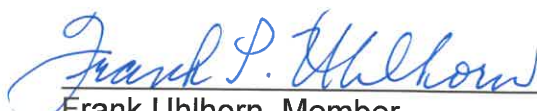

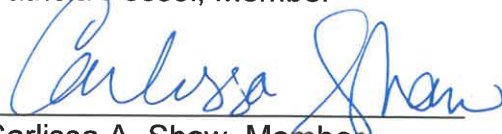
