WHEREAS, The Election Commission has determined that the polling locations for **03-10 St. Ann Catholic Church** located at **6529 Stage Road, Bartlett, TN 38134** and **06-06 Eastside Baptist Church**, located at **3232 Covington Pike, Memphis TN 38128**, are not available for the **May 5, 2026, Shelby County Primary Election** by the Shelby County Election Commission and,

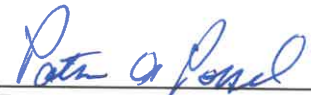
WHEREAS, the replacement polling locations, **Bartlett Hills Baptist Church** located at **4641 Ellendale Road, Bartlett TN 38135**, and **Raleigh United Methodist Church**, located at **3295 Powers Road, Memphis, TN 38128**, have consented to the use of their facilities as election day polling locations for **03-10 & 06-06** and meets the Election Commission site standards,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SHELBY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION, that **03-10 St. Ann Catholic Church** located at **6529 Stage Road, Bartlett, TN 38134** and **06-06 Eastside Baptist Church**, located at **3232 Covington Pike, Memphis TN 38128** will be replaced with **03-10 Bartlett Hills Baptist Church** located at **4641 Ellendale Road, Bartlett TN 38135**, and **06-06 Raleigh United Methodist Church**, located at **3295 Powers Road, Memphis, TN 38128**, the replacements are hereby approved.

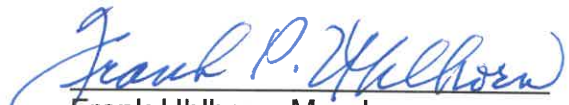

**Administrator's Report****April 2026**

- **Early Voting - Is** going well; our numbers are ahead of 2018, which was the most equivalent election. Most of our issues are related to candidates and campaign workers. Many of the candidates are regarding the 100 ft line as a mere suggestion: not TCA § 2-7-111 (b) (1). Violation of the 100 ft boundary is Class C misdemeanor under the provisions of TCA § 2-19-119
- **Building Update** –The cameras are being installed. We are still waiting on the gate controllers. We are still awaiting some furniture.
- **Anne Dallas Dudley Gold Award - Secretary** of State Tre Hargett was in Shelby County on April 16th to present the Anne Dallas Dudley Gold awards. He stopped by the Operations Center to tour our renovated facilities. Many thanks to Commissioner Possel for accompanying the Secretary to the schools.
- **Public Test - The** public test of EV and ED machines were held; the auditors found no issues.
- **Candidates Running for 2 Offices** - Should a person who is a candidate for both a federal office and a state office, win both general elections, the person would have to resign one of the offices as state law doesn't allow a person to hold both offices. We would then have a special election to fill the vacant office.
- **Outreach** – Has been extremely busy with high school registration events. We will again have a booth at the Memphis in May BBQ Festival from May 13 to 16th in Liberty Park. This will feature an election to seek people's opinions about favorite types of BBQ.
